- —All communication should be appropriate for a professional audience, including people of many different backgrounds. Sexualized language and imagery are not appropriate.
- Be kind to others. Do not insult or put down anyone, regardless of professional status and personal opinions.
- All participants of the WTD 2025 are encouraged to speak up if they observe inappropriate behavior and report it to the contact points listed below. Reports will be treated confidentially if the reporting person requests it.

Participants that are asked to stop any inappropriate behavior are expected to comply immediately. The WTD 2025 organizers will decide about expelling participants from the workshop who continue to violate these rules.
